Study these examples from the text on page 40:

- Do we use *a lot of* different plants and animals for food?
- We only use *a few* plants and animals for food.
- How *much* land and water does it take to produce meat?
- It takes *a lot of* land and water.
- *Many* people in Asia, Africa and South America eat insects.
- We'll need to provide *enough* protein for billions more mouths.
- There is *a little* space for farming.

The words: *many, much, a lot of, a few, a little, enough* are quantifiers (they give information about the quantity of nouns)

NOTE:

1 *Enough* comes before a noun (pre imenice): There isn't *enough* food. But after adjective or adverb (posle prideva ili priloga): I'm not fit *enough*. Let's go! We've waited long *enough*.

2 We can use *too much* or *too many* to mean: more than we need or want.

I've got *too much* homework.

You shouldn't buy *too many* cans of fizzy drink.
